## **Day 3. Wedderburn & Inglewood District**

Take a drive through the natural bushlands stopping off on part of the Wedderburn Goldfields where you will be given a Gold Detecting demonstration. Hold a genuine gold nugget found on Wedderburn's Goldfields.



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Visit the Loddon Visitor Information Centre situated in what was Wedderburn's original Primary School, relax and enjoy your morning tea followed by a stroll through the Eucalyptus Discovery Centre

View Wedderburn's Community Garden where you can see the "Kangaroo Chair" which is an interactive sculpture, shaped like a large club lounge with Kangaroo legs and tail.

Visit Melville Caves in Kooyoora State Park. Relax in natural surroundings, whilst enjoying its scenic and historic values

Stroll along the Historic Main Street of Inglewood - Visit a Doll Museum, which comprises of dolls, prams and cots from the late 1880's to today Jumeau to Barbie. In total 2,500 dolls and 50 prams are on display. The display changes periodically as there is sufficient room for the entire collection. All situated in 5 rooms of an early Victorian Hotel in the old town of Inglewood

Before departing a 1 course meal will be served from the Loddon Bridge, Empire State or Royal Hotel.
