Day 1. Tarnagulla District

On arrival to the Loddon Shire Tourism Region at 11.30am lunch is in the lounge of the cosy Newbridge Hotel. (1course meal includes cuppa)

Town tour of Tarnagulla the country town of churches.

Take a ride on Loddon's Miniature Steam Train.

View the breathtaking Loddon River at Laanecoorie.

Visit McIntyre’s Run a cottage style industry, producing home-style jams and chutneys from mostly local produce.

Settle in at the Wedderburn Goldseeker Motel.

Dinner in Motel Restaurant.

Day 2. Pyramid & Dingee District

Visit Dingee the Home of the “White Clover and experience real farming life stopping off at a local Dairy. Take a guide tour through the Dingee Catholic Church. Enjoy you morning tea at the Dingee Progress Park.

With a guide take a stroll through Pyramid Hill Historical Society & Museum that has fabulous collection from the pioneer days.

Lunch in the Victoria Hotel in Pyramid Hill. (1course meal includes cuppa)

Via the coach visit “Pyramid Salt” and learn how salt is extracted from the ground. View the different varieties of Salt that are produced at Pyramid Hill.

Dinner at the Wedderburn Hotel - inspect the mural of the Wedderburn goldfields and see the rare white fox. Entertainment by local musician



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Day 3. Boort District

Breakfast in the Gold seeker Restaurant

The Lanyon family finished growing tomatoes for processing factories after thirty years, and now have become the manufacturer. Visitors are welcomed to Simply Tomatoes who encounter a tour of on farm manufacturing operations of green tomato products.

Information is shared about the farm, the district and the progressive story of Simply Tomatoes. The tourists enter the world of a farming family and the journey of national award winning products, also recognized by the Premier of Victoria for innovation.

A picnic box for morning tea is enjoyed in the ambience of our cottage garden. The tour concludes in the showroom where visitors are able to view and purchase a DVD and Simply Tomatoes products.

The latest addition to our farm is Aussie Wool Quilts. We proudly produce Australian wool bedding. See how they are made from chemical free pure and natural wool with pre-shrunk cotton covers making them low allergenic, perfect for allergy sufferers. View our collection of Quilts, Pillows and Under blankets which are available for sale.

Visit Glencoe Fish Hatchery. This hatchery is an enclosed environmentally controlled, state of the art facility including a number of Australia's largest domesticated Murray Cod.

Lunch in the lounge of the friendly Commercial Hotel or Railway Hotel (1course meal includes cuppa)

Saluté Oliva means: "Cheers to good health with Olives". Saluté Oliva is situated at the eastern edge of Boort. This family owned grove produces first class extra virgin olive oil and a range of table olives. Grown organically and processed following traditional pickling methods, using only natural ingredients. The oil and the olives are available in various package sizes. Also sold on site are olive oil soaps and gift pack.

A guided tour through Boort's Olive Plantation by Timbercorp. This plantation when fully established may be the largest olive growing district in the world.

Stroll through the two acre garden has many large sculptures, made from old and antique spanners they are placed amongst trees and garden beds. Birds are also a feature, especially a netted orchard that has hundreds of birds of many types. A collection of old horse-drawn equipment totally 84, line the front and back drive ways. Many other interesting things are to be seen as you walk through the garden.

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Day 4. Wedderburn District

Breakfast in the Goldseeker Motel Restaurant.

Demonstration at Cuzz's Studio on pyrography onto Tasmanian sassafras bowls

Take a drive through the natural bushlands stopping off on part of the Wedderburn Goldfields where you will be given a Gold Detecting demonstration. Hold a genuine gold nugget found on Wedderburn's Goldfields.

Visit the Loddon Visitor Information Centre situated in what was Wedderburn's original Primary School, relax and enjoy your morning tea followed by a stroll through the Eucalyptus Discovery Centre

Stroll through Wedderburn's Historic General Store with a magnificent collection from the gold rush era

Visit the stone historic Anglican Church.

Watch the process of Eucalyptus Oil being stewed in a Eucalyptus "STEW POT" and smell the lovely essence of True Blue Mallee Eucalyptus Oil. Enjoy a nice country style lunch.

Visit Wedderburn's Community Garden where you can see the "Kangaroo Chair" which is an interactive sculpture, shaped like a large club lounge with Kangaroo legs and tail.

Dinner in Goldseeker Motel Restaurant with entertainment by the famous Wedderburn Oldtimers Orchestra.

Day 5. Inglewood District

Breakfast in the Goldseeker Motel Restaurant.

Melville Caves in Kooyoorra State Park

In what once was Inglewood's Courthouse sit back and enjoy a reenactment of court hearings of the 1870's that were published in the Inglewood Advertiser.

A guided tour of Inglewood's Aurora Masonic Lodge, relax and enjoy your morning tea.
